DOCUMENTARY AWARD "REMEMBRANCE AND FUTURE" ON TOUR

In cooperation with the foundation "Remembrance, Responsibility and Future" and other partners, goEast presents the DOCUMENTARY AWARD "REMEMBRANCE AND FUTURE" ON TOUR in Leipzig, Tallinn, Freiburg and Berlin. The prizewinner of 2009 KOCHAM POLSKĘ / I LOVE POLAND by Polish directors Joanna Sławińska and Maria Zmarz-Koczanowicz will be screened on the 17th of November in the Forum of Contemporary History in Leipzig and on the 30th of November within the frame of the 13th Tallinn Black Nights Film Festival. The Slovakian documentary BLIND LOVES/ SLEPÉ LÁSKY (Director: Juraj Lehotský) will be shown at the Municipal Cinema in Freiburg on the 4th of December. The last screening will be at Arsenal Cinema in Berlin on the 14th of December, presenting the Serbian fairytale-documentary GOODBYE, HOW ARE YOU? / DO VIDJENJA, KAKO STE? by Boris Mitić. The films will be screened in attendance of the directors and followed by panel discussions with film critics, experts of documentaries and adepts of Eastern Europe.

FILMTALK WITH CROSSING BOUNDARIES-PRIZEWINNERS AND FESTIVAL DIRECTOR NADJA RADEMACHER

Young directors from Eastern European, German and Israeli filmacademies present their awarded short films at the conference "Crossing Boundaries (1939 – 1989 – 2009)". The prizewinners of the competition awarded by the Goethe Institute and the foundation „Remembrance, Responsibility and Future“ will be talking with Jakob Hoffmann (Protestant Filmjury) and Nadja Rademacher (Director goEast Film Festival) in Arnoldshain / Frankfurt.

THE CO-PRODUCTIONPRIZE FOR YOUNG GERMAN AND EASTERN EUROPEAN FILMMAKERS

The Robert Bosch Stiftung issues three Co-Production Prize for Young German and Eastern European Filmmakers. The prize, worth up to 70,000 euros for each selected project, is awarded at the goEast Film Festival in the categories animated film, documentary, and short film. Young filmmakers in the fields of production, directing, camera, and screenwriting are given an opportunity to explore the methods and creative styles of their partner country.
